**TEFILLAH**

Students begin each morning in a structured reflective setting, with options ranging from creative experiences to art, yoga to discussion, formal prayer to journaling.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

Students must complete 1.5 credits of Physical Education to graduate.

**FRESHSEM**

Our 9th grade seminar helps students learning how to build relationships, make healthy decisions, manage stress, and improve executive functioning and study skills.

**SERVICE LEARNING**

Over their four years, students gain the knowledge and skills to offer effective and meaningful service in our communities.

**SENIOR KEYSTONE PROJECT**

The senior Keystone Project is a culminating educational exercise that provides students with the opportunity to design and implement a multi-faceted project on the topic of their choice, demonstrating the culmination of four years of learning at JCHS. Each senior then presents their Keystone Project to the school community.

**PATHWAYS**

Completion of one of the Jewish Engagement Pathways:  
 1. 1 additional Jewish Studies elective  
 2. 4 years of Hebrew  
 3. Participation in the Jewish Engagement Pathways cohort (starting with the Class of 2028 for the 2026/27 school year)
